SPEAKERS REVIEW by Pat Barron

Dave Biffen's wife Patty, a proud native of Coatesville, introduced James Ziegler, director of the National Iron and Steel Heritage Museum there.

The museum's website--www.steelmuseum.org--has a wealth of information about what is available in Coatesville to learn more about this industry. I'll just hit some of Mr. Ziegler's highlights, such as that the plant in Coatesville is the longest running plant in continuous operation in North America. Wow, I had no idea! It started operations in 1739 and is still running.

I bet you didn't know that ninety percent of the ships in the US Navy fleet have some Coatesville steel plate. Steel from the Coatesville plant was used in the World Trade Center, and some of that steel was repatriated to Coatesville in a solemn convoy of well over twenty vehicles to construct a memorial park there. Coatesville steel was used in many prominent Philadelphia structures plus the Seattle Space Needle and the St. Louis Arch.

Museum property covers fourteen acres in Coatesville around the intersection of Routes 82 and 30. It's right in our backyard, so we all should visit.
