SPEAKERS REVIEW by Danielle Mortimer

The Rotary Club of West Chester had the pleasure of two Classification Talks. The speakers were Donald Neimentz and Jill Stoltzfus. Donald is the Executive Director of North Star of Chester County while Jill is a Career Readiness Coordinator at Chester County Technical College High School.

North Star of Chester county guides single working parents with dependent children who are at risk of homelessness toward stability and financial independence. They help participant families remain in safe, affordable housing as they work to secure their future through a structured program of financial assistance, mentoring, and supportive services.

They provide 3 years of financial assistance to help families avoid homelessness, provide monthly budgeting with a case manager to help develop and achieve financial goals, provide workshops to help parents increase income and decrease expenses, sponsor children's activities, and provide gently used furniture.

Donald joined Rotary for personal growth, business organization development, to serve the community, and for fellowship. We are so lucky to have him and North Star as part of our community.

Our speaker Jill is a Career Readiness Coordinator at Chester County Technical College High School which is part of the CCIU. They are designed to partner with other districts and charter schools to provide skills to these schools. There are 3 schools throughout the county and 24 different programs from trades to health care pathways. Last year they started to offer adult programs to offer certifications to graduates. Students in all of their programs have the opportunity to earn dual enrollment credits. They offer a new platform called Career Ready Chesco where any business can register to offer career awareness activities such as presentations, interviews with students, or internships.

Jill joined Rotary because she is patriotic, wants to give back to her community, wants to increase community awareness, for networking opportunities, and for leadership development. We are so lucky to have her and The Chester County Technical College High School in our organization and community.
