

Of great interest in Mr. Burke's presentation were many photos of historic West Chester Buildings, several of which were designed by **Thomas Ustick Walter** (1820s to 1800s), a Philadelphia architect who became famous for the design of the preent U.S. Capitol building and dome in Washington, D.C.



Among the buildings in West Chester designed by Thomas U. Walter are the First Presbyterian Church (1832), Bank of Chester County on High Street (1836), Chester County Prison (1838, demolished 1960 for the new County Justice Center), West Chester Young Ladies Seminary (1838), Chester County Courthouse (1846–47) and the Chester County Horticultural Hall (1848, now part of the History Center).
