SPEAKERS REVIEW by Danielle Mortimer

On November 4th, we had the pleasure of meeting Christopher Curtin, Master Chocolatier and pastry chef of Éclat Chocolate, located in West Chester, PA.

He is the first American to be awarded the title of Master Pastry Chef and Chocolatier in Cologne, Germany in 1996. On top of that, his chocolates have won the Best Truffle in America award by Food and Wine Magazine and the Good Food Award for outstanding American craft food products.

Curtin shared with us an in depth look at the cocoa

been selection, picking, and fermenting process. Some fun facts he covered are that cocoa beans begin fermenting the moment they are picked, and they are extremely acidic and will even dissolve the bed of the truck they are transported in after some time!

Curtin hand selects "chocolate experiences" in the finest chocolate houses of Belgium, France, Germany, Switzerland, Spain, and Japan. He is always trying to get "more innovative and improve the experience." He makes chocolates shaped like bunnies and filled with peanut butter for Easter, pumpkin pie filled chocolates for the fall, and Christmas boxes that change variety every year!

Many of their high quality, limited ingredient chocolates are very popular at Whole Foods and hotels, as well as often being used for corporate gifts. They really go above and beyond – using only sustainable ingredients, and local products whenever possible!
