#### **PROGRAM**

Local pickleball professiona **Bill Raup** was our guest speaker to tell the membership about the game of pickleball and where to play it in our area.



Pickleball is a racket or paddle sport in which two (singles) or four (doubles) players hit a perforated, hollow plastic

ball with paddles over a 34-inch-high (0.86 m) net until one side is unable to return the ball or commits an infraction. Pickleball is played indoors and outdoors. It was invented in 1965 as a children's backyard game in the United States.

Bill told us tht four pickleball courts can fit in the size of one tennis court. So the amount of movement required is much less than tennis – one reason that the sport appeals to all ages.



While there are many places to play pickleball, Bill told us about the new YMCA Pickleball Center in Downingtown (across the street from Pepperidge Farm) - which is free to Brandywine YMCA members. Bill teaches beginners and more advanced players at this facility.
