## Rotary International

**Annual Fund:** Support Foundation grants and activities worldwide. Eligible for [Paul Harris Fellow](#) recognition. Make a one-time gift or enroll in recurring giving.



**PolioPlus Fund:** End Polio Now. Be a part of history and help Rotary achieve a polio-free world. Eligible for [Paul Harris Fellow](#) recognition and includes an option to support General Secretary John Hewko's Ride to End Polio. Make a one-time gift or enroll in recurring giving.

**Permanent Fund:** Help secure the Foundation of tomorrow. The fund also supports the Rotary Peace Centers. Eligible for [Benefactor](#) recognition. Make a one-time gift or enroll in recurring giving.

## Janesville Rotary Club

The Janesville Rotary Club collects membership dues and pays Rotary International and District member dues. Any club social activities and supplies pass through the Rotary Club. The budget is designed to typically break even.

## Janesville Noon Rotary Foundation

**Foundation:** 501(c)(3) organization. All funds raised through fundraising efforts of the Janesville Noon Rotary Club go through the foundation. Funds are used to support all of the worthwhile projects of our Club. Donations may be made to the Janesville Rotary Foundation to support current year project funding. The Janesville Rotary Foundation can apply for Grants from Rotary International which come out of the RI Annual Fund.

**Endowment:** 501 (c)(3) organization created to provide life long sustainability of the Janesville Noon Rotary Foundation projects such as Camp Rotamer, Rotary Gardens and all other projects of the Foundation. Donations made to the Janesville Rotary Endowment are in perpetuity. This means that no principal dollars may ever be removed from the Endowment. Annual earnings of the Endowment are transferred to the Janesville Rotary Foundation to support current year funding needs. Eligible for [George S. Parker Fellow](#) recognition and [Benefactor](#) recognition.
