

# Community Action for Recovery and Diversion (CARD)

#### THE 90/10 MODEL TO CRIMINAL CONDUCT




## York County Drug Deaths



- ☐ Heroin/Opioid Deaths represent 89 95% of drug deaths in each of the past 6 years
- ☐ There was an 82% increase in heroin deaths between 2016-2017 alone

#### **Wellness Courts**

(10% of Justice Involved Opioid/other serious substance abusers)

#### Remainder of Justice System

(90% of Justice Involved Opioid Abusers)

Heroin Involved; MH Cases; DUI; Shoplifting; Simple Possession; other not "high risk/high needs", or don't apply to wellness court;


(may not receive treatment)

#### BENEFITS OF CARD

- ✓ Evidence based approach to reducing recidivism
- ✓ Eliminate the silos that preclude coordination
- √ Force Multiplier w/ coord. Of Justice/Public Health
- ✓ Avoid Duplication of Resources/Contracts/Expense
- ✓ Early Intervention Saves Lives, Raises Public Safety
- ✓ Deferred Cases Save Tax Dollars/Promotes Economy

#### **CARD Parameters**

- CARD is focused upon addressing the drivers of repeat criminal conduct in populations whose negative conduct can be improved by help with their mental health and substance abuse issues.
- CARD is not a replacement in the criminal justice system for punishing criminals who engage in violent behavior, prey upon others, or who have no interest in reforming their antisocial behavior.
- CARD is an accountability program that allows persons who have run afoul of the law to address the underlying social, public health, and trauma issues that are often the catalyst for criminal behavior.
- As with the treatment courts, those who take the opportunity to improve their situation through CARD will reap short term legal benefits and long term life benefits. Those who do not follow through with treatment/recovery opportunities will face traditional justice outcomes.
