able to help care for the younger children when he finishes. The course runs for 18 months.

Elizabeth Kakenya Masoi Sowing and Reaping

Elizabeth did very well in school but didn't start until she was older and so as she is now almost 20 has decided to follow what she wants to do and that is catering. She is doing very well, getting 95% in her practicals and 92% in her theory. Her mother passed away when she was young and is not able to live at home as her father chooses not to care for her. She has enjoyed learning more cooking techniques since she has been home for holidays.

FEES/LIVING/EXAMS PER YEAR: \$980

Mary Lepishoi Likama Narok Technical Institute

Mary's father has 3 wives and many children and is not willing to help the girls with furthering their education. Mary

is studying Catering and has 1 year to finish.

FEES/LIVING/EXAMS FOR FULL COURSE (12 MONTHS): \$625

Ezekiel Lemashon Narok Technical Institute

Ezekiel came to work for KINI approximately 12 months ago and we realised he was very industrious

and wanted to do something to help his family and his future. He dropped out of school in Form 1 due

to the family not being able to pay his school fees. He is studying plumbing and enjoying it immensely.

He has 6 months to finish.

FEES FOR REMAINDER OF COURSE (6 MONTHS): \$400

Abraham Lekishon Kilgoris Journalism College

Abraham is an orphan who has no-one to care for him. KINI has been sponsoring him since Form 1

and he has now completed one year of Journalism, the course he has always wanted to do. He is doing well.

FEES/LIVING PER YEAR (3 Terms): \$2,025 (2 years to finish)

## SECONDARY STUDENTS

Margaret Noolamai (Kilgoris Girls) Form 3

Margaret is now in Form 3 and will finish school at the end of next year. Margaret is an orphan who lives with her grandmother who is not able to care for her education. Without KINI's help she

would be left at home where she would be married off or sent to work as a maid and have no future hope.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Zipporah Chura Nyabisase Mixed Secondary (Form 2)

Zipporah is in Form 2 and is doing very well. Her mother is the one who is to care for the family but she is not able to pay school fees and Zipporah is often sent home from school

and misses classes.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Maureen Chebet Cheptoo (Form 3) Kapkulumben Secondary

Maureen is from a very poor family, a single mother who has 4 children and no way of earning an

income. Maureen is in Form 3 and will finish at the end of 2024. She was not able to go to school

until KINI was able to help. The older girl in the family has not been able to continue in school.

FEES PER YEAR: \$500 (3 terms per year)

Elizabeth Saitoti Musuka (Form 3) Oyugi Ogango Girls Secondary

Elizabeth has no family who is able to care for her or educate her. She lives with her aunt who has

other children and is a widow so is not able to pay for her school fees. She will finish at the end of 2024.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Sylvia Sialo Tompoi (Form 3) Maasai Girls Secondary

Sylvia's father has 2 wives and refuses to care for Sylvia's mother or her children. The mother is not

able to pay fees for Sylvia so if she is not in school the father will ensure she is married. She will finish at the end of 2024.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Musa Lemayian (Form 3) Chebilat Boys Secondary

KINI has cared for Musa since he was 8 years of age. His mother passed away and left the father with 5 young children to care for. He does not have paying work so finds it very difficult to pay fees

for all his children. Musa will finish at the end of 2024.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Ishmael Bett (Form 3) Boito Boys Secondary

Ishmael is very bright and is in a very good school where he is always near the top of the class. His father left the

family and the mother is struggling with the children left and those in school who have not been able to go

to good schools as she cannot afford the fees. He will finish in 2024.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Amon Kipkoech Byegon (Form 3) Boito Boys Secondary

Amon's father passed away 2 years ago and left his wife with 10 children to care for with very little collateral to help

her. Amon was doing well and KINI moved him to a better school where he could learn better. He will finish

at the end of 2024.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Rebecca Selelo Leno (Form 2) Ndanai Girls Secondary

Rebecca lives with an aunt who is not able to send her to school. She is from a remote area with a single mother who cannot keep her safe with her. She will be taken to be married or will likely become pregnant should she not remain in school.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Susan Sanare (Form 2) Gelegele Girls Secondary

Susan is from a single mother who cannot afford for her to go to school. As with other Maasai if she is not in school the uncles will marry her off.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Enock Kembol (Form 3) Kenegut Secondary

Enock's father is not able to care for any of the children in his family and therefore the uncle must pay Enock's fees as well as his siblings. His uncle finds it difficult to pay for his own children as well as Enock. He will finish in 2024.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Tito Nampayio (Form 1) Chellilis Girls Secondary

Tito's mother passed away in 2012 leaving 5 children who only had an aged grandmother to care for them. KINI has taken care of all the children since this time, paying for their education and the older daughter has lived in the KINI Home since 2014. Tito is in a good school and she is working hard to get good marks.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Rebecca Morinte (Form 1) Chelilise Girls

Rebecca has done well in Primary School but her parents have struggled to pay fees and were not able to pay for her to join Secondary. KINI has promised to help with fees should a sponsor be found. Like

all Maasai girls who are not in school, she would be in danger of exploitation without our help.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Grace Nayianoi Nkaminen (Form 1) Kilgoris Girls Secondary

Grace is from a very poor family who have not been able to educate their children because of lack of fees. Grace walked very far to a primary school where they asked KINI to help her. She passed well and is now working hard in Secondary. Without a sponsor she

will not be able to continue her studies.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Jacqueline Tempesia Kuyia (Form 1) Gelegele Girls Secondary School

Jacqueline's father has 2 wives and a number of children and struggles to keep them all in school and requested KINI's help to ensure the daughter finishes her education.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Emily Tampei (Form 1) Sosiot Girls Secondary

Emily is a very bright girl from a very poor family. Her father does not take responsibility for any

expenses, including school fees, in the home. Her mother has no income but tries to get small monies to help ensure her children are in school. She works very hard to ensure this. If Emily had

not been sent to school she would have been married as she would not have been able to stay at home if not in school. KINI has helped Emily to get into Form 1 to ensure her place in school but needs a sponsor to make sure she is able to stay there.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Koyanto Julius (Form 1) Tulwet Boys Secondary

Koyanto's mother works for KINI Mara Academy earning a small wages to buy food for her family as her husband doesn't help with any finances for the family. Koyanto is a very good footballer but is studying hard to pass well.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Emmanuel Parsoilal (Form 1) Tulwet Boys Secondary

Emmanuel's father has 3 wives and is not willing to educate this family's children. The mother struggles to keep the 8 children in school and cared for.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

David Mbirika Kituiya (Form 1) Kabartegan Boys Secondary

David is from our local community. His father passed away some years ago and his mother isn't well, thus finds it difficult to raise money to educate the children. If these boys are not in school they are often sent out to look after cattle and become involved in many antisocial behaviours.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Henry Ochieng (Form 1) Kanga Boys Secondary

Henry was recommended by a Principal from a National School. Henry's mother is blind and cannot look after him or his siblings. Henry ended up on the streets until his grandmother took him

in but she is not able to pay for any of his schooling. He got one of the highest marks in his primary

school and was accepted to a very good school. Fees/Shopping is \$700 per annum.

FEES PER YEAR: \$700 (3 terms per year)

Gloria Chemutai (Form 1) Tengecha Girls Secondary

A school teacher has requested KINI help this girl as she has a single mother who is not able to put her in school. She does very well and is in a very good highly sought after school. The neighbours and teacher have done shopping so fees only are needed \$600

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Sheila Chebet (Form 1) Saseta Girls Secondary

Again teachers have requested help for this girl who has only a mother and no income with other siblings to keep in school. Friends are helping with shopping so fees are needed for her to continue her education and have a hope for the future.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Sarah Naeku Wilson (Form 3) Sangera Parish Girls Secondary

Sarah is the last born of a family of 6. Sadly her father does not support the family and the mother

struggles to provide basics. She has completed Form 2 and will now proceed to Form 3. Without KINI's help she will not be able to complete her schooling and her father will take the opportunity to

marry her off. Sarah stays in the KINI Home to ensure her continued protection.

FEES/LIVING PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Rebecca Naimutie (Form 2) Gelegele Girls Secondary

Rebecca is in Form 2. She is the youngest daughter from a large family and her father is not able to provide for her schooling and her brothers are struggling to ensure others in the family are in school.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Jane Nankine Mempe (Form 1) Chelilis Girls Secondary

Jane's father passed away when she was quite young and her mother struggles to ensure her 4 children are in school. Jane now in Form 1 and her mother asked KINI to support her to ensure she continues in school and does not succumb to the problems for young girls in her community.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Sankau Shuruu (Form 1) Moi Minarete Boys Secondary

Sankau did well in his Primary School exams and so was able to get into a school that is performing well. His mother is a widow with 5 children still in school. She works very hard keeping the children in school but it is very difficult to pay boarding fees with no income. Her dream is for all her children to complete Form 4 and go onto tertiary education.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Sharley Koitat Kiserian (Form 3) Olorukoti Secondary

Sharley's father does not care for her schooling as he wants her to stay at home. KINI put her into Secondary School as she was afraid if she stayed at home the father will force her to marry. She ran away to stay with the Pastor of her church who has been helping her stay in school. However, he is not able to pay school fees. Without a sponsor she will not be able to finish school and follow her dream to go to University. She will finish school at the end of 2024.

FEES PER YEAR: \$500 (3 terms per year)

Moses Tekan (Form 2) Chebilat Boys Secondary

Moses father abandoned the family leaving the mother and grandmother to care for the 6 children. Moses is now in Form 2 in a good school and we expect good results from him this year. Without a sponsor KINI will not be able to continue to help him finish school and help his mother care for the other children.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Hellen Naserian Lekakeny (Form 1) Kilgoris Girls Secondary School

Hellen's father refuses to pay for her to attend school and the mother struggles to find school fees. KINI has been supporting Hellen through Primary School but without a sponsor it will be very difficult to complete her education. The only option her father would see is to marry her off as happens with most girls who are not sent to Secondary School.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Samwel Sonkoi (Form 1) Boito Boys Secondary School

KINI had a call from Samwel's primary school to request KINI to pay Samwel's school fees. He is

an orphaned boy who has no grandparents and whose Uncles will not care for him, thus he is left to live with a relative. This relative has many children of his own and is not able to pay school fees. He did well in Grade 8 and has now gone to Secondary School where he will do very well..

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

Naini Loice Sokonoi (Form 1) Gelegele Girls Secondary School

Naini now lives in Barbara's home because her family circumstances did not keep her safe nor allow her to study. Her mother passed away 4 years ago and it has been difficult for the father to care for and educate the children as he has remarried and has a number of small children now to care for. Naini has gone to Secondary School where she is very happy and working hard to get good marks.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year) and \$200 per year for her living expenses

Kevin Kirui (Form 1) Kaplong Boys Secondary School

Kevin is from a very poor family of 13 children and is now living with an Aunt as his parents cannot take care of him. He did well in his primary exams and has been accepted to a top secondary school where he is expected to do well.

FEES PER YEAR: \$600 (3 terms per year)

PRIMARY SCHOOL STUDENTS

Anna Mutasia (Grade 8) Iltolish Mara Primary School

Anna lives in Barbara's home and has done so for the past 4 years as her parents passed away and when Barbara found her she was not allowed to go to school, nor was she being cared for in a good manner. Since coming to our home she has thrived and is very intelligent doing extremely well in school. Next year she will go to Secondary School

FEES: \$400 (3 terms per year)

Emmanuel Robert (Grade 5) and Letipa Sophie Sienoi Robert (Grade 3) Saparingo Primary School.

They are brother and sister. They have a single mother who struggles to pay their fees. They are in day school and will need help for the next 3 years.

FEES: \$100 (3 terms per year)

Namunu Morinte Paranai (Grade 7) in Emerutoto Junior Secondary School.

Namunu lost her father 5 years ago and her mother does not have an income and struggles to ensure her 4 children are in school.

FEES: \$300 (3 terms per year)

Elizabeth Pererua (Grade 8) Emerutoto Primary School

Elizabeth is from a family where the father will not send them to school. She is now in Grade 8 and will go to secondary school next year. Without KINI's support she will be sent home and married off.

FEES: \$300 (3 terms per year)

Naomi Sempeyo Leina (Grade 7) Emerutoto Junior Secondary School

Naomi's father does not care for the family in any way and the mother has to stay in her family's home because of the violence, therefore Naomi has no safe place to stay and is now staying in the KINI home.

FEES/LIVING: \$400 (3 terms per year)

Lucy Barbara (Grade 5) Emerutoto Primary School

Lucy is now 13 years and has lived with Barbara in the KINI home since she was 6 years of age. Her

mother passed away and the father could not care for the children and the grandmother wasn't willing to care for the children. The children will need to stay with KINI for the rest of their lives here.

FEES/LIVING: \$300 (3 terms per year)

Lemayian Samuel (Grade 6) Olkirreruki Primary School

Lemayian's father has 3 wives and is not willing to care for the schooling of all the children. The mother struggles taking care and educating her other 6 children. Lemayian is a day student so the fees are quite low for the year.

FEES: \$100 (3 terms per year)

Gedion Lankas (Grade 7) Olkirreruki Junior Secondary School)

Gedion's mother is the only provider for the family of 6 children and struggles to find funds to feed the family as

well as educate the children. They live in a very remote forested area so opportunities to get money is very

low.

FEES: \$100 (3 terms per year)

Emily Masoi (Grade 5) Iltolish Mara Primary School – Boarding

Emily is Elizabeth's sister and is not cared for by her father or new stepmother (who is very young). She has been put into boarding to ensure her safety and she has opportunity to study.

FEES: \$400 (3 terms per year)

Elkana Samperu Masoi (Grade 2) and Kerempe Masoi (Grade 3) Iltolish Mara Primary School

Elkana and Kerempe are brothers to Elizabeth and Emily. Their father is not able to pay for their schooling and they will not be put into school if KINI did not care for them.

FEES: \$200 (3 terms per year)

Leah Maitete (Grade 8) Iltolish Mara Primary School

Leah is from a remote forest community and her mother is left to care for the children and educate them. As she is a second wife with 6 children the husband does not help with their education or upkeep.

FEES: \$400 (3 terms per year)

Rebecca Tampeyian Kipasenua (Grade 8) Iltolish Mara Primary School

Rebecca is from a single mother who walks 2 hours each way every morning to sell milk to educate her children, some in university and Secondary. They live in a remote forested area so if girls are not in school they are very quickly married off.

FEES: \$400 (3 terms per year)

Leah Lekumo (Grade 8) Oloosinon Primary School

Leah was brought from her home by a friend of KINI where she is now staying as her father had arranged for her to be married, she was only 13 years at the time. Without KINI's support she will

not be able to continue her schooling. Next year she will go to secondary school.

FEES: \$300 (3 terms per year)

Sarah Nesiayi Parsaloi (Grade 8) Oloosinon Primary School

Sarah has a single mother who struggles to care for her 6 children and ensure they are all in school. Without KINI's support she will not be able to go to Secondary School next year.

FEES: \$300 (3 terms per year)

Neema Potisoi (Grade 8) Kapkoros Junior Academy

Neema is an orphan who lives with a family who have cared for her since she was very young. As the family have other children in secondary school and also university. She will go to Secondary School next year.

FEES: \$400 (3 terms per year)



Brian Olamunyak (Grade 6) Emerutoto Primary School

Brian's mother is single and is not able to care for Brian as she cares for his 4 younger sisters.

Brian

is doing well in school and will continue to Junior Secondary next year.

FEES: \$100 (3 terms per year)

Praize Chelangai (Grade 4) Rockfield Academy.

Praize has a single mother who is not able to care for her and other family do not have the funds to

help educate her.

FEES: \$300 (3 terms per year)

Miriam Onyoku (Grade 5) Oloomongi Primary School

Miriam is from a very dangerous situation in her home and will need to come to stay in the KINI home to ensure she is going to remain in school and be safe. Without our help she will be married off, even though she is very young.

FEES: \$100 (3 terms per year)

Susan Seleyian Ntae (Grade 8) in Emerutoto Primary School

Susan's family is very poor and the father does not take responsibility for the children or their education. There are 10 children in her family. If KINI does not continue with her sponsorship her father will marry her off. Next year she will go into Secondary School but she will need a sponsor to ensure her fees are paid.

FEES PER YEAR: \$300 (3 terms per year)

Brian Julius (Grade 3) Ilolish Mara Primary School

Brian is from a very poor family who struggle to educate their 3 children. Fees are very low as he attends a day school close to his home.

FEES PER YEAR: \$100 (3 terms per year)

Raphael Mungare (Grade 7) Fr John Kaiser Junior Secondary School

Raphael is in to Grade 7 and does well in school.

His mother is alone in caring for him and his brother who is in Secondary School and struggles to

ensure his fees are paid.

FEES PER YEAR: \$430 (3 terms per year)

Matthew Jackson (Grade 8) Fr John Kaiser Primary School

Mathew is one of 6 children and his family struggle to educate all the children. Mathew does well

in school and to ensure he reaches his potential it was decided to send him away from the local school to a boarding school in the closest town. He is currently in Grade and doing very well.

FEES PER YEAR: \$430 (3 terms per year)

Maxwell Kiplagat (Grade 8) Ilkarian Primary School

Maxwell is a very bright boy. Sadly his mother is not able to care for him as she has a mental illness and he has been left to care for his younger siblings and roam the streets of the small town. A local business man has taken him into his home and KINI has agreed to share his care with providing education expenses. A bright boy who deserves a bright future. Next year he will go to Secondary School and without a sponsor this will not happen.

FEES PER YEAR: \$300 (3 terms per year)

Maxwell Memusi Ranka and Nasayio Ruth Ranka (Grade 4) Isokon Academy

Maxwell and Ruth are brother and sister both in Grade 4. Their father passed away leaving 4 wives and a large number of children. Sadly both mothers are not well and have no way of obtaining money to care for the children. Visiting their homes we found they have no food in the home and rely on the goodwill of relatives and neighbours. We have placed them both in a private school where they have a good meal for lunch each day. Both are in the top positions in the class.

FEES PER YEAR: \$265 (3 terms per year)

Dorcas Pirsia (Grade 6) Partakilat Primary School

Dorcas is in Grade 6 and is sister to Moses Tekan. The father abandoned the family leaving the mother and grandmother to care for the 6 children. Dorcas does well at a day school near her home. She needs to go into Boarding school now she is in Grade 6.

FEES PER YEAR: \$300 (3 terms per year)

Maxwell Muchunga (Grade 7) Karen C Primary School.

Maxwell is in Grade 7 and studying very well. His father also cares for 3 other orphaned children as

well as his own 4 children and is very difficult to ensure they are all in school and able to finish their education.

FEES PER YEAR: \$480 (3 terms per year)

Tobiko Jackson (Class 8) Iltolish Mara Primary School

Tobiko is from a single mother who has mental health issues and therefore is cared for by his grandparents and uncle. His uncle struggles to pay school fees for his own children as well as his sister's 5 children (Tobiko is the eldest). He will go to Secondary School in 2024.

FEES PER YEAR: \$300 (3 terms per year)

Salome Letohuo (Class 7) Kishomorua Primary School

The head teacher of the primary school where Salome attends contacted the Director to help the girl as she is from a remote area and the family is too poor to help her stay in school. The father wanted to marry her off, being in school ensures she is safe.

FEES PER YEAR: \$300 (3 terms per year)

Enkereri School is the school closest to the Manyatta where Barbara lives and KINI has supported quite a

number of children in this school for 10 years and continues to support children from here into Secondary

School. A large number of the children are partially supported which means KINI pays 50% of fees and where

parents or guardians are able, they pay the remainder. Some children, because of very poor circumstances,

especially where aged grandparents are responsible for their fees, have their full fees paid.

Those whose full fees are paid (boarding) Full year's fees for 3 children \$250 each = \$750

All these children are now in Class 8 and will proceed to Secondary School in 2024
