THE ROTARY CLUB OF ANGEL FIRE SCHOLARSHIP

Each year the Rotary Club of Angel Fire awards scholarships to students attending Moreno Valley High School/Cimarron High School who plan to attend either a two year or four-year college or university or vocational school. Graduating High School Seniors, or others planning to attend college for the first time are eligible to apply. Applicants must have a 2.5 GPA.

The primary basis for awarding the scholarship is: “Does the applicant reflect in their past achievements and in their career objective the principles and ideals of Rotary as presented in **THE OBJECT OF ROTARY** and **THE FOUR-WAY TEST**? Serious consideration is also given to academic achievement, service in the community/world, leadership experience and financial need.

THE OBJECT OF ROTARY

The object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

1. The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;
2. High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying by each Rotarian of his occupation as an opportunity to serve society.
3. The application of the ideal of service by every Rotarian
4. to his personal, business, and community life.
5. The advancement of international understanding, good will, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional men and women united in the ideal of service.
