Create Real Jobs

Rotary Clubs and members work in partnership with **Inclusion Alberta** to develop jobs for people with developmental disabilities within the business community. Together we explore the possibility of creating genuine and meaningful employment opportunities.

Rotary members explore their networks and talk to people about inclusive hiring. If they know of a potential employer, they connect the employer with Inclusion Alberta. Individual Rotary members may also consider the possibility of creating an employment opportunity for a person with developmental disabilities.

Inclusion Alberta connects employers to potential employees with developmental disabilities. Inclusion Alberta and PDD will also provide the resources, expertise and on-the-job supports to ensure a successful outcome.

This partnership offers the opportunity for employers and employees to learn how to sustain and facilitate the successful inclusion of people with developmental disabilities in the workforce.

Through this initiative there is the potential for Rotary Clubs and members to directly and personally make a powerful and wonderful difference in the life of a person with developmental disabilities.
