Funding Guidelines:

- Must pass the Rotary 4 way test:
 - o Is it the Truth?
 - o Is it fair to all concerned?
 - O Will it build good will and better friendships?
 - o Will it be beneficial to all concerned?
- Projects must benefit the people of Olds & District [local Community projects], qualify as a Rotary International Project, or fall under Rotary Youth Development
- Grants are awarded for a definite purpose and/or project.
 - If the project changes from the original approval the Rotary Club of Olds reserves the right to change the funding agreement or revoke approval of funding
- Applications are considered on merit and in light of funds available for distribution.
- Preference is given to programs and projects which
 - o Promote group or community volunteer participation and collaboration
 - o Opportunities for the advancement of the Club's image in the community (visible signage and media coverage)
- All applications for funding should be submitted 60 days prior to funding requirement
- All applications shall be submitted to the Communities, New Generations, or international committee via email to info@oldsrotary.com
- Person(s) or group requesting funding may be requested to present to the appropriate committee. An additional presentation at a regular club meeting may be required if further consultation is needed.

The following are ineligible for funding:

- Retro-active funding
- Direct religious activities and political activities
- On-going core operating expenses & regular staff wages
